Project Porchlight Brings CFL Bulbs to Vineland

VINELAND — Despite cool, wet weather, the Third Annual Rock-n-Roll-n-Ribs-n-Chili Cook-off on Sept. 26 was a sizzlin' success. Hundreds of people turned out to sample selections from local professional chefs and amateurs and listen to music performed by some excellent blues and rock bands.
